**Aroma:** Savage, meaty with hints of vanilla. Fresh leather, with a burnt dark fruit component in the background.

**Palate:** Intense powerful, ample dark fruit, spice and ripe black fruits open expressively into a full mid-palate of jerky, fresh plum and supple, long tannins.

## Multi-Vintage Syrah

Santa Barbara County

We set out to make an extended barrel-aged Syrah like the successful and popular wine we made a few years ago as a wine club exclusive.

We held back a few age-worthy barrels from recent vintages to make this exceptional wine.

This is only the third Multi-Vintage Syrah we have made in our 18 years of making wine. Why? It takes years to collect the right wines from both younger vintages and age-worthy older barrel lots to make a blend as special as this cuvée.

The 53 cases produced will only be available through the wine club and tasting rooms.

After carefully considering trial blends, here are the final components of Margerum Multi-Vintage Syrah. All of these vineyards fall within the Santa Barbara County appellation.
